Message from CEO

I am pleased to present this years' last newsletter. The new highlights include the celebration of Adoption Awareness Month 2023 in various parts of the country. Additionally, various programmes for awareness and outreach along with Prospective Adoptive Parents (PAPs) meets have been conducted by various states. In Delhi, CARA organized an Adoption Awareness Conclave with various PAPs and stakeholders focusing on the theme of 'Adoption of Older Children'. An online campaign, in collaboration with MyGoV India, featured various activities such as online pledge-taking activity, quiz and poster-making competitions.

Various IT related initiatives have been initiated to further simplify CARINGS. Starting from December 4, 2023, the referral cycle for RI/NRI/OCI & Foreign PAPs is being executed thrice a week on Monday (10:00 AM), Wednesday (11:00 AM), and Friday (12:00 Noon). Additionally, a 7-day cycle for RI/NRI/OCI PAPs Tab is being executed every Tuesday and Thursday at 10:00 AM.

Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its direction dated 20-11-2023 has issued certain directions pertaining to identification of children. The efforts of the Hon'ble Supreme Court to prioritize basic child rights in such situations are commendable. It's vital to create avenues for these children to access their fundamental rights and opportunities for a better future. The focus on their welfare reflects a commitment to equity and justice for all children, irrespective of their circumstances.

This newsletter contains updates on recent initiatives, details about adoption trainings, projects, and success stories, all of which signify the effort and hard work involved in each case.

SUCESS STORY:

In just 14 days family got completed through Step Parent Adoption

Sense of accomplishment is felt when an adoption process is completed. The Sailo's (name changed) life changed just before he turned 18 years.

Sailo's step father wanted him to have all the rights of the biological child. So, he decided to adopt him legally and hence registered himself on CARINGS for Step Adoption on 14th November, 2023. However Sailo and his parent were not sure, if the adoption process could be completed in such a short span, as he was about to be 18 years old on 12th of December, 2023.

Sailo and his family were worried and continuously thinking, what, if the process is not completed on time? However, fate had a beautiful plan for the family as the Adoption Order was issued when Sailo was 17 years, 11 month & 16 days old and he legally became child of his step father.

In just 14 days, the entire step adoption procedure was completed by CARA, SARA, DCPU & District Magistrate Aizawl, Mizoram.
