SUCCESS STORY :

A boy found his permanent family in his relation

Once upon a time, there was a young boy named Bhuvan (name changed). When his mother passed away, his biological father was not able to take care of him. But probably, fate had a different plan for him! Ms. Radhika, his paternal aunt, who was taking his care, decided to legally adopt him through CARA. Though Bhuvan was already 17 years and 11 months old, she was worried if the legal adoption would be possible in such a small span of time.

However, she registered herself on CARINGS under the category of Relative Adoption on March 7 and completed all documents by 10 April 2023. Permission was granted by CARA within a period of 3 days to go ahead with the adoption. The role of SARA was commendable. The District Magistrate concerned in Mizoram issued the adoption order and Bhuvan could now enjoy all the rights of the biological child. Within such a short span Bhuvan got blessed to have a Loving Mother and a Permanent Home.

SUCCESS STORY :

His Family got completed when he got adopted by Step Father

Sachin's (name changed) whole life changed when he was just about to be 18 years old. His family was just his biological mother an Uzbekistan citizen, living in India. He always felt incomplete without a father. Then came a moment when he found his father in a person introduced by his mother. He was willing to be Sachin's father. They got to know that CARA is the only organisation that does legal adoption for Indian children. On June 15, 2023, around 2 months before Sachin's 18th birthday, they registered with CARA, to finally adopt him and give legal status to the relationship.

Hope and anticipation filled their heart with Joy! On August 29, 2023 the Adoption Order was issued by District magistrate. Sachin's life transformed, at the age of 17 years, 11 months, and 24 days, he got loving father too.
