(d)	Whether the Government has received complaints regarding complicated formalities involved in the adoption procedure, if so, the details thereof; and	The Government has received complaints relating to delays/difficulties in implementation of certain provisions of the JJ Act, 2015 and Adoption Regulations, 2017. These include problems in medical examination reports of children in Specialised Adoption Agencies (SAAs) and Child Care Institutions (CCIs), difficulties/delays in obtaining adoption orders from Family/District Courts, and difficulties/delays in obtaining birth certificates and passports etc.	
(e)	The action taken by the Government to simplify child adoption procedure in the country?	The Ministry has introduced the JJ Amendment Bill, 2018 in Lok Sabha on 6 th August, 2018 to amend provisions of the JJ Act, 2015 to replace "court" with "District Magistrate" under Sections 56(5), 58(3), 58(4), 59(7), 59(8), 60(1), 61(2), (63), (64) and 65(4) of the JJ Act, 2015.
