Subject: Adoption of children having temporary special Needs

In accordance with the Adoption Regulations, 2022, notified by the Government of India on September 23, 2022, Schedule III is designated for Medical Examination Report and Classification of Special Needs of the Child. In Part 'E' of the Schedule III of Adoption Regulations, 2022, following conditions are marked as temporary special needs . Such cases require close follow up and evaluation of the special needs status periodically. Some of these special needs category may become typically developing or normal children.

- a. Squint
- b. Cataract
- c. Cleft lip or palate or both
- d. Hernia
- e. Disfiguring Birth Mark
- f. Burns
- g. Nutritional Disorders and Deficiency States

In accordance with this temporary special needs categorization, all State Stakeholders (SAAs and CCIs) are asked to take initiative to organize corrective surgeries/ treatment for such children before uploading their CSR, MER & LFA on CARINGS in coordination with DCPU,CMO,DM and SARA concerned. Schedule III of the Adoption Rules, 2022 may be carefully examined in this regard. A copy of the Adoption Regulations 2022 may be downloaded from CARA website(https://cara.nic.in).
