As we step into the final quarter of the year, I am pleased to reflect on the significant strides we've made in our ongoing mission to ensure that every child has the opportunity to grow in a safe, loving, and supportive environment. Our work is rooted in collaboration, capacity building, and continued engagement with all stakeholders involved in child adoption, and this period has been marked by some noteworthy milestones that I would like to share with you.

At CARA, we are committed to enhancing the capabilities of all those involved in the child adoption process. As part of our capacity-building efforts, we have conducted regular refresher training sessions for SARAs, DCPUs, CWCs, SAAs and CCIs. These trainings are designed not only to strengthen the knowledge base of professionals but also to ensure that we remain at the forefront of best practices in child adoption and welfare.

Our team has been actively engaging with communities across remote districts. This includes visits and meetings with stakeholders of Prayagraj, Mumbai, Amaravati, Pune, Ahmednagar, Solapur, Satara, Sangli, Thane, Raigad, Palghar, Nashik, Dhule, Jalgaon, Nandurbar, Bhopal, Hoshangabad, Raisen, Sehore, and Vidisha. These visits allowed us to meet local stakeholders, understand the unique challenges faced by each district, and ensure that child welfare practices are being effectively implemented at the grassroot level.

On September 17th and November 29th, 2024, we hosted Live Q&A sessions for Prospective Adoptive Parents and key stakeholders. This initiative provided an invaluable platform for prospective parents to ask questions, share concerns, and better understand the adoption process. It is our goal to ensure that families feel wellinformed, supported, and confident as they embark on their journey to adopt a child. The session was a testament to the importance of open dialogue and building trust in the adoption system.

At CARA we also prioritize fostering social responsibility. Over the past month, we have actively participated in several establishment-related activities:

- Hindi Pakhwara: Promoting the use of Hindi as a medium of communication and fostering national integration.
- Swachhata hi Seva: Engaging in cleanliness drives that contribute to building a cleaner and more hygienic environment for children and their communities.
- Vigilance Awareness Week: Reinforcing our commitment to integrity, transparency, and accountability in all
- National Unity Day: Celebrating the spirit of unity and recognizing the strength of our diverse nation in promoting a collective approach towards child rights and welfare.
