As you all are aware, one of the key principles of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 is to mobilise all resources including those of family and community, for promoting the well-being, facilitating development of identity and providing an inclusive and enabling environment, to reduce vulnerabilities of children. The Act emphasizes on well-being of each child which is of paramount consideration.

The foundation of India's adoption system particularly under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 (amended in 2021) is rightfully meticulous and child-centric, and that the fundamentals of this process are sound and robust. However, it has been observed by various authorities and agencies including CARA and the Ministry of Women and Child Development, GOI that the system can be improved and streamlined further so as to benefit children whose lives are greatly impacted by adoption through their placement with loving and caring families.

Section 68 of the JJ Act, provides that one of the key functions of CARA is to frame Regulations on adoption and related matters from time to time as may be necessary. The Ministry held several rounds of meetings with CARA to review its activities and in response, CARA held a number of capacity building programmes, webinars for framing revised Regulations to improve its operation.

As, Chairperson of the Steering Committee of CARA, I would like to express my gratitude to all those who have worked tirelessly and contributed to the cause of adoption directly or indirectly. I would particularly compliment the Prospective Adoptive Parents adopting older children and children having special needs and putting an end to their institutionalisation as these children are undergoing challenging physical and mental conditions.

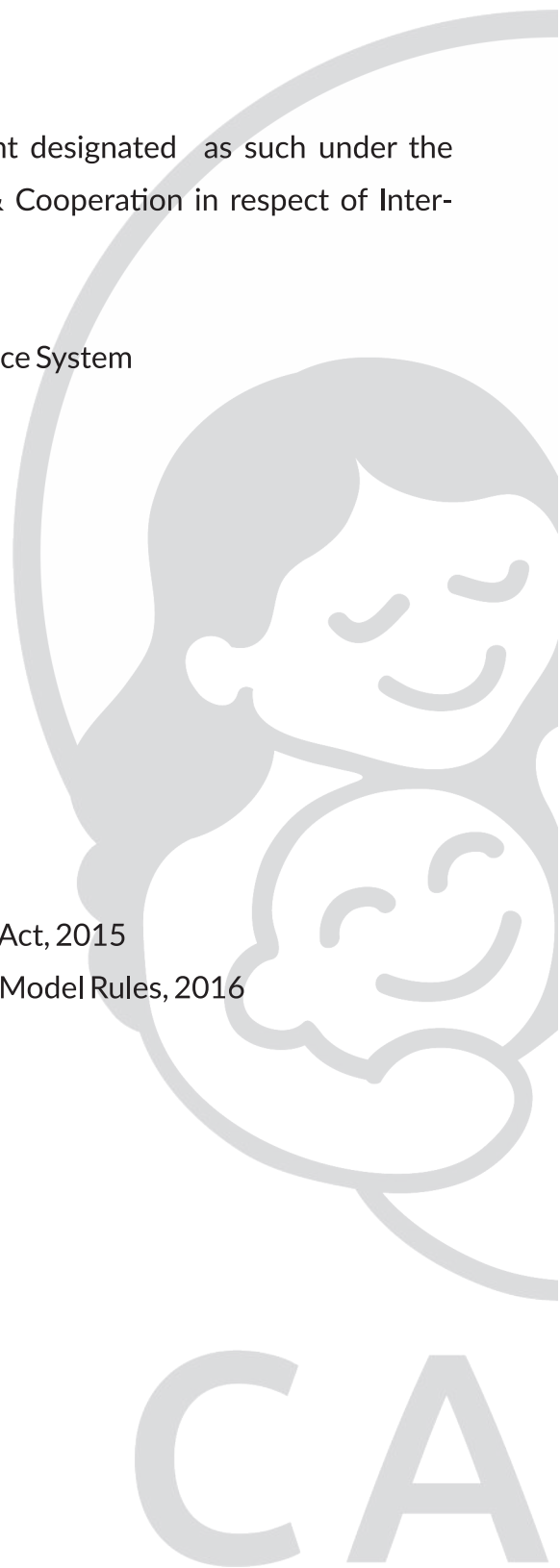

Introduction

1.1 Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA)

1.1.1 Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA) was set up in June 1990 by the Ministry of Welfare, Government of India to regulate, monitor and promote adoption of orphan, abandoned or surrendered children, with the principal mandate of finding loving families for Children in Need of Care and Protection. Pursuant to a decision of the Union Cabinet dated 2nd July 1998, the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment conferred autonomous status to CARA on 18th March 1999 by registering it as a Society under the Societies Registration Act 1860. Adoption under the Juvenile Justice Act 2000 enabled placement of children in adoption with involvement of recognised agencies and authorities for ensuring safeguards to adoption placement of institutionalised children.

1.1.2 Through Section 68 of the JJ Act 2015 notified by the Government of India on January 15, 2016, CARA attained the status of a Statutory Body with the mandate to promote incountry adoptions; facilitate interstate adoptions; frame regulations on adoption related matters and regulate inter-country adoption and function as Central Authority under the Hague Convention for inter-country adoption through Child Adoption Resource Information & Guidance System (CARINGS). CARA aspires to place

maximum children in non-institutional care with adoptive families. CARA was designated as Central Authority under the Hague Convention on Protection of Children and Co-operation in respect of inter-country adoptions (1993) in 2003. Central Adoption Resource Authority is headed by Member Secretary & CEO and has a sanctioned strength of 37 officers and staff.

1.1.3 Under Section 68 of the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act 2015, CARA has been mandated to perform the following functions :-

- (a) To promote in-country adoptions and to facilitate inter-state adoptions in coordination with State Agencies;
- (b) To regulate inter-country adoptions;
- (c) To frame regulations on adoption and related matters from time to time, as may be necessary;
- (d) To carry out the functions of the Central Authority under the Hague Convention on Protection of Children & Cooperation in respect of inter-country adoption;
- (e) Other functions as provided under Regulations 37 of the Adoption Regulations 2017.

1.2 Steering Committee of CARA

1.2.1 The Steering Committee of CARA has been

constituted under Section 69 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 by the Ministry of Women and Child Development vide its O.M. No. - CW-II/26/7/2015-CW-II dated 22/03/2016 with the tenure of two years w.e.f. 15/01/2016. The present composition of Steering Committee vide Notification No. 3035 dated 12/08/2021 published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (ii), with the tenure of two years w.e.f 12/08/2021 of CARA is given below: -

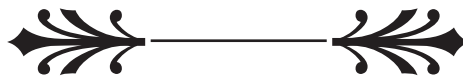

Recent Government Notifications

In recent years, the Central Government has made various significant announcements about adoption-related issues, and texts have been incorporated into the proposed amendment of the Adoption Regulations-2017.

- I. Right of Overseas Citizens of India Card holders (OCI) (4.3.2021): Registered Overseas Citizens of India have been granted parity with Non-Resident Indians in the matter of adoption, as per notice dtd 4.3.2021.
- II. Amendments in the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 in 2021 (9.8.2021): The Juvenile Justice Act 2015 has been amended through Govt. notification on 9.8.2021 and one of the most important features of the amendments is that it includes authorizing District Magistrate including Additional District Magistrate to issue adoption orders under Section 61 of the JJ Act, in order to ensure speedy disposal of cases and enhance accountability. "District Magistrate has to function as the Grievance Redressal Authority and the Divisional Commissioner as Appellate Authority in the matter of adoption." The District Magistrates have been further empowered under the Act, to ensure its smooth implementation, as well as to garner synergised efforts in favour of

children in distress conditions.

- III. Role of Indian Missions abroad (11.8.2021): On 11.8.2021, the Central Government came out with the notification enabling the Indian adoptive parents to relocate abroad even without completing their post-adoption follow-up and their post-adoption follow-up reports to be completed by the Indian Missions abroad.
- IV. Regulations on Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act, 1956 (HAMA) (17.9.2021): On 17th Sept 2021, Government has notified "Procedure for children adopted under the Hindu Adoption & Maintenance Act, 1956 by persons who desire to relocate a child abroad" to simplify procedure related to adoption by Hindu Prospective Adoptive Parents or Adoptive Parents residing outside the country. CARA has been empowered to issue NOC in such cases of adoptions on the basis of verification by the District Magistrate and necessary permission from the receiving country.

Since the release of the government notification, district magistrates have granted 22 HAMA verification certificates between April 2021 and March 2022.

Important Programmes and Activities

3.1 SAA-CCI Linkage

Linkage between Specialised Adoption Agencies (SAAs) and Child Care Institutions (CCIs) has been established with a view to reach every child without parental care. The SAA-CCI linkage has been expedited in the States and UTs as per the order passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for mandatory registration and linkages of CCIs with SAAs with a view to reach every child without parental care. As on 30/12/2021, 5925 Child Care Institutions (CCIs) have been registered as per the provision of Section 41 of the JJ Act, 2015, out of which 5725 CCIs have been linked to SAAs and remaining CCIs are pending for linkage as Section 66 of the JJ Act, 2015. This does not include the existing 484 SAAs who are also CCIs as per Section 2(21) of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 (amended in 2021). A number of children in Child Care Institutions other than Specialised Adoption Agencies got family during the period.

3.2 CARA Helpline and handling of grievances:

The grievances are received primarily from Prospective Adoptive Parents (PAPs) including other stakeholders in the adoption process. The nature of grievances are mainly on medical grounds, delay in adoption process, seniority status, rejection by Adoption Committee of SAA, etc. Timely intervention by CARA is done in cases where there are delays in Court proceedings,

pendency at the level of Child Welfare Committee and in the matter of passport and birth certificate etc.

The complete grievance site is being redesigned to guarantee a competent complaint management procedure that tackles concerns in a timely, respectful, and proactive manner, safeguarding the institution's reputation, enforcing high compliance standards, and holding authorities accountable for non-compliance.

3.3 Review of Parliamentary Committee

A meeting of the Parliamentary Sub Committee on "Review of Guardianship and Adoption Laws" was also held on 17.11.2021, the Parliamentary Committee also visited a local adoption agency to assess the functioning of the adoption programme and it has raised some queries which are being responded separately. States have been found to be enforcing various provisions of the JJ Act to streamline adoption procedures at various stages, including pre-adoption, adoption, and post-adoption, with the involvement of the CWC, DCPU, and SAA

3.4 State Coordination

The In-Country Coordination section coordinated with States/Union Territories (UTs) & various stakeholders associated with

the adoption process which includes State Adoption Resource Agencies (SARAs), District Child Protection Units (DCPUs), Child Welfare Committees (CWCs), Specialised Adoption Agencies (SAAs) and Child Care Institutions (CCIs) across the country.

The section accomplished the task pertaining to issuance of support letters in cases of in-country adoptions to visit/re-locate abroad and pre-approval letters required for in-country adoptions.

The section also carried out other activities such as weekly referral cycle, physical/telephonic counselling, redressal of grievances received from Prospective Adoptive Parents (PAPs) & Adoption Agencies and issues pertaining to CARINGS Portal. Efforts have been made to reduce delays at the level of CWC and Court.

3.5 Rehabilitation of Special Needs and Older Children

During the financial year and especially during the adoption month CARA paid special attention for rehabilitating children with special needs. A special needs child is a child who is mentally ill or physically challenged or both. The main disabilities include visual impairment, cerebral palsy, cleft lip palate, clubbed feet, hearing impairment, etc. During international adoption month, November a total number of 496 children had been made live on CARINGS portal for the purpose of rehabilitating them with families who were

open to adopting children with special needs. During 15th November to 16th December 2022, 285 Special Need Children were reserved.

3.6 Suggestions sought on Adoption Regulations

With a backdrop of several government notifications in the year 2021 (Amendments in the JJ Act 2015 in 2021 on 9.8.2021, notification of Regulations on HAMA on 17.9.2021, notification on Right of OCI Card holders on 4.3.2021 and Role of Indian Missions abroad on 11.8.2021 and observations made by the stakeholders for revisions to the Regulations, it was thought necessary to make changes to the existing Regulations to further simplify the system and streamline the country's adoption programme. In this regard, several consultations were made with all stakeholders.

3.7 Programme in Jammu and Kashmir

Union territory Jammu and Kashmir, erstwhile a state, has constituted a State Adoption Resource Agency(SARA) to deal with adoption related matters under the guidance of the Central Adoption Resource Agency constituted in terms of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015. It would also function as the executive arm of the Jammu and Kashmir government for promotion, facilitation, monitoring and regulation of the adoption programme in the UT and perform such functions as are prescribed under adoption regulations, 2017 issued by the Ministry of Child Development.

3.8 COVID-19 initiatives

During the unprecedented spread of the Novel Coronavirus COVID-19 in the Country, National Lockdown and subsequent issuance of Guidelines for Unlock, CARA facilitated smooth functioning of the Adoption Programme in accordance with the travel/precautionary Advisories issued by the Government of India.

3.9 Child Adoption Resource Information & Guidance System (CARINGS)

3.9.1 Child Adoption Resource Information & Guidance System (CARINGS), an e-governance initiative on adoption and hosted on the official website of CARA i.e. www.cara.nic.in, wherein control based access has been given to various stake holders. It integrates the two databases, it was launched in February 2011, further revamped in 2015, and is being hosted on the official website of CARA i.e. www.cara.nic.in. This web based monitoring system provides a transparent and child friendly adoption process across the nation. It facilitates expeditious and smooth adoption, ensures transparency in the adoption process, increases accountability of implementing agencies, creates a network of stakeholders and maintains a national database to enable effective policy making and research. CARINGS provides online monitoring of the adoption and post adoption process by CARA at Central level and SARA at the State level.

3.9.2 CARINGS has become the heart of the

adoption process and has excelled as an e-governance tool and it has been designated as the only system or platform through which legal adoptions can be processed. CARINGS provides platform to around 484 Specialized Adoption Agencies, 734 District Child Protection Units and 34 State Adoption Resource Agencies with the country and also for international bodies like Central Authorities of receiving countries, 65 Authorised Foreign Adoption Agencies, 44 Central Authorities and 21 Indian Diplomatic Missions Abroad to connect with CARA.

3.9.3 The automated system matches the children available for adoption automatically with that of the choice given by parents and gives online referrals automatically without any human intervention. The system can be altered dynamically to take policy based decisions automatically as and when there is a requirement to do so on review of the policies. There are two operational modules (implementing and monitoring modules) for discharging the functions of agencies and authorities in a user friendly online web interface. It enables the authorities and agencies to perform the following functions:-

3.9.4 The new simplified online portal called CARINGS 3.2 has been made operational during this period including new in-country relative adoption & In-country post adoption follow-up modules. Through the relative adoption portal, CARA is able to collect the information on domestic relative & step

adoption. Further, with the post adoption follow-up module, the pending status of such reports can be monitored. The entire Adoption process can be monitored online through CARINGS by CARA and its stakeholders.

- SARA and DCPU are mandated to monitor the activities of the SAAs at local level.
- Monitoring adoption process online helps in understanding delays at various levels and plug the gaps in the system.
- Data analysis is possible for taking important decisions in a timely manner.
- Registration of adoption agencies on CARINGS.
- Online registration of PAPs.
- Early placement of special needs children.
- Post-adoption follow-ups to be recorded online.
- Adoption of children placed in other CCIs through linkage with SAA.
- Ensuring priority to domestic adoption.
- PAPs feedback module has been created to receive the suggestion/feedback from PAPs

3.10 Training & Development Activities:

In order to train and spread awareness on the Adoption Programme and to promote legal adoptions in the country, CARA has been organizing orientation and training programmes for various stakeholders. Details have been enumerated in the succeeding paragraphs. There has been a deliberate shift in activities due to unprecedented situation of global pandemic COVID-19 with the Government's initiatives of lockdown.

3.11 Adoption Awareness Month–November 2021

Month of November is celebrated as Adoption Awareness Month. The theme of this year's International Adoption Month was "Adoption of Divyang and Older Children". During the **Adoption Awareness Month, November 2021**, profile of a total of **496** Special Needs Children were updated on CARINGS Portal for the purpose of adoption. The Special Need Children were classified according to Schedule XVIII of Adoption Regulations, 2017. The main

disabilities included visual impairment, cerebral palsy, cleft lip-cleft palate, club feet, hearing impairment, congenital heart disease, haemophilia, hepatitis B+, Hernia, HIV, hydrocephalus, low birth weight, premature birth, missing organs, speech dysfunction, thalassemia, tumour, intellectual disability, autism, seizures, mental illness and spinal bifida an overwhelming response was received forand. As a direct result of this drive more than 50 percent of special need children, 274 children were reserved by the prospective adoptive parents within a

month. During the month, CARA organised the following programmes:

- ❑ Webinar held on 01-11-2021 and 15-11-21 on Amendments of the Adoption Regulations 2017 with participants which included Indian diplomatic missions, State Govt., SARAs and DCPUs.
- ❑ Interactive meets with 05 States (Bihar, UP, Karnataka, Maharashtra, and West Bengal) to create necessary sensitisation amongst the stakeholders. CARA officials also visited two SAAs in each to understand their issues and concerns.
- ❑ Two regional level programmes organised in collaboration with the NIPCCD, Guwahati for DCPUs & SARAs in North Eastern States.

3.11.1 Adoptive Parents and Prospective Adoptive Parents Meet, Bangalore

Shri Sanjay Barshilia, Director (Programme) and Shri Samuel Vargheese P., Assistant Director (Programme) visited SAA namely St. Michael's Home Convent and Mathruchayaon 19-11-21. They were

accompanied by State government officials. Adoptive Parents and Prospective Adoptive Parents Meet was held on 20-11-2021 at Jawahar Bal Bhawan, Bangalore. The programme was inaugurated by Ms Pallavi Akurathi, Director, ICPS and SARA, Karnataka. Shri Sanjay Barshilia, Director Programme CARA explained about the recent amendments in JJ Act 2021 and other changes in Adoption Regulations. He also answered to the queries raised by the Adoptive Parents as well as the Prospective Adoptive Parents in the event. Both adoptive parents and the prospective adoptive parents shared their experience. During the meet with Director ICPS Karnataka and Director CARA released a few booklets related to child development activities carried out by SARA Karnataka. Beautiful cultural programmes were organised by the children of SAAs. A total of 300 Adoptive Parents as well as the Prospective Adoptive Parents participated in the program.

Procedure for children adopted under the Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act, 1956, by parents who desire to relocate child abroad has been laid down in the Govt. notification dtd 17.9.2021 enabled NRI/OCI PAPs to adopt with less procedural formalities.

Statutory Compliances

4.1 Compliance of the Right to Information (RTI) Act, 2005

4.1.1 CARA has nominated Sh. Kamal Kishor, Dy. Director (A) as Nodal Officer for RTI Act, two Central Public Information Officers (CPIO) (one each for Administration Division and Programme Division) and an Appellate Authority (AA) under the Right to Information (RTI) Act, 2005. During the year 2021-22, CARA has received a total number of 318 online/offline RTI applications (direct/transferred cases). Out of 318 RTI

applications, CPIO (CARA) has responded and given replies of 279 RTI applications (disposed/transferred) during the year 2021-22.

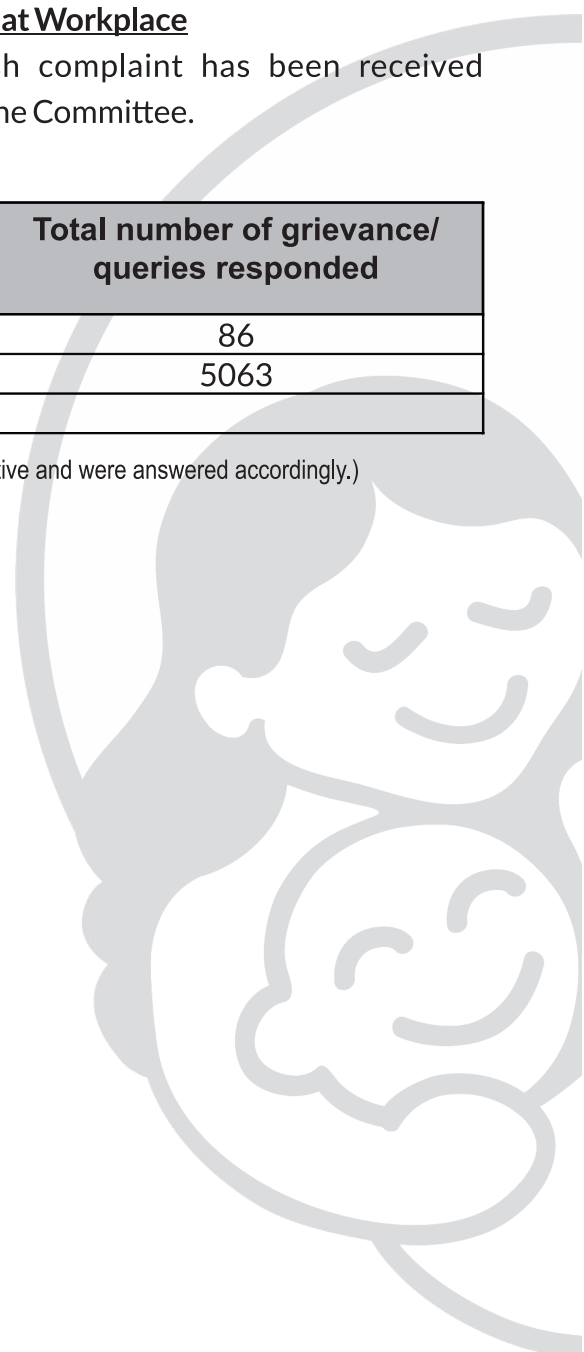
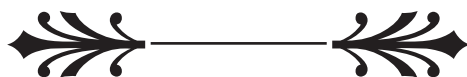

Dear Chief Secretary,

Today the Country is dealing with one of the most severe pandemics in recent history of human civilization. While we are resolute in our commitment to prevent and protect all our citizens, I wish to draw your attention towards the issues impacting children in these circumstances. Their perils range from loss of daily routine and related mental distress to losing their loved ones and parents to COVID.

2. The Ministry had issued advisories and guidelines for encouraging COVID appropriate behavior, monitoring of Child care Institutions and coping strategies during COVID times for de-stressing children, last year. Recently, support for Child psychosocial care & counseling by SAMVAD(Support, Advocacy & Mental health interventions for children in Vulnerable circumstances And Distress)-a national initiative managed by NIMHANS with support of Ministry of Women and child Development, has also been extended to all stakeholders vide OM dt. 27.04.21.I am hopeful that due action is being taken for care and protection of children already registered in juvenile justice set up, including Child care Institutions. However, immediate measures are to be taken for children recently orphaned due to COVID.

3. Under section 2(14) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 (hereinafter mentioned as the Act), children without parents or care givers are defined as children in need of care and protection. The Act and Rules made thereunder mandate a safety net of service delivery structures along with institutional and non-institutional care for these children. It also prescribes detailed Standard Operating procedure for rehabilitation of such children.

4. The Ministry is also implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme namely Child Protection Services (CPS) in partnership with the State Governments /UT Administrations for delivering the institutional and non-institutional care as stipulated under the Act. A 24x7 helpline for children, called Childline is also implemented under the scheme, for extending outreach and support to children in distress situations

5. In light of the foregoing, I would request you to direct the District Magistrate in all the Districts of your State/UT to ensure that immediate action is taken for rehabilitation of COVID orphaned children in accordance with the provisions of the Act, and rules thereunder, while leveraging the facilities funded under the scheme for Child protection Services.

6. It may be ensured that such children are produced before the Child Welfare Committee (CWC) within 24 hours, excluding the time necessary for the journey (Section 31 of the Act). Digital platform for interaction may be used in exceptional cases where physical interaction is not possible in current circumstances due to COVID related restrictions. The CWC shall ascertain the immediate need of the child and pass appropriate orders for rehabilitation of the Child(Section 37of the Act), either to restore the child to care givers or place her/him in Institutional or non-Institutional care, on case to case basis. Effort should be made to sustain the children in their family and community environment as far as possible, while ensuring their safety in their surroundings and safeguarding their interest, as prescribed under the Act. If the Child is restored to any kind of kinship care, CWC will continue to check the well being of the child on regular basis. Care must be taken to protect the identity of the Child to avoid undue distress to her/him, as provisioned under section 74 of the Act. COVID protocols as prescribed by the competent authority may be followed, while delivering these responsibilities.

7. The information about any child who has lost both the parents may be shared with Childline (1098). The local Childline unit will contact the child to confirm the case and ascertain the well-being of COVID orphaned child. Childline will help produce the Child before the CWC within 24 hours. Local Childline unit will also assist CWC in monitoring the well-being of the Child as and when required.

8. The District administration under the District Magistrate may take all necessary measures to restore normalcy in the life of COVID orphaned child on immediate basis. In this regard, the District Magistrate shall be assisted by all the stakeholder agencies, including those working for protection of children i.e. local Police, District Child protection unit, local Childline unit, Child Welfare Committees etc.

9. The District Magistrates may also be asked to review the action taken regarding such children on daily basis, and submit a report to the State government. State Commission for protection of Child Rights may also be involved in monitoring the status of these children. A weekly report may be submitted to Ministry in this regard.

10. Your personal intervention in this matter, along with periodic review, will be extremely helpful to ensure proper rehabilitation of COVID orphaned children on priority.

Dear Madam/Sir,

It has come to the notice of Ministry that several children are facing serious distress in the event of parents getting infected or hospitalised due to COVID. Some of them have lost their parents to pandemic. COVID being an infectious disease, community support is often restrained, making children extremely vulnerable. In these situations, it is imperative to provide immediate support and rehabilitation to these children under juvenile justice set up. In this regard, a letter dated 30.04.21 has been written by Secretary, Ministry of Women and Child development, to the Chief Secretary of your State, requesting to ensure immediate action for rehabilitation of COVID orphaned children, in accordance with the provisions of the JJ Act and leveraging the facilities under Child protection services.


2. A meeting with all the States/UTs was also held under the chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of Women and Child Development on 30th April 2021, to assess the situation and needs of women and children during the COVID pandemic presently. It was learnt that some of the States (Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh) have designated one Child Care Institution (CCI) or Fit facility in each district, to provide temporary shelter for few days to the children whose parents are affected with COVID and have been hospitalized. It is a good initiative, useful for children whose parents are unable to take care of them temporarily. Hence it is requested that at least one CCI in each district may be identified to support children for the interim period, when their parents are indisposed due to COVID.

3. All the hospitals and COVID care facilities in the District may be informed regarding the arrangement. Contact details of Child Welfare Committee members, designated Child care Institutions (to support children during parents' illness), and Childline number (1098) may be prominently displayed at the reception of the hospital or COVID care facility. The hospital reception can guide the parents to send the children to such Child care Institutions. They may also inform Child welfare committee or Childline, in case children of any patient are found facing difficulty. District administration may be asked to ensure display of 1098 and Child Welfare Committee (CWC) numbers at other public places also.

4. You may also consider issuing a public notice in the local language, to guide public regarding lawful course of action to be taken in case of children who have lost their parents to COVID and have no one to take care of them.
5. Your personal intervention and supervision in this matter will be greatly helpful in ensuring best interest of children during the COVID pandemic.

Separate Audit Report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India on the Accounts of Central Adoption Resource Authority, New Delhi for the year ended 31st March 2022.

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA), New Delhi as at 31st March 2022, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account for the year ended on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service Act, 1971 read with Section 73(2) of the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015. These financial statements are the responsibility of CARA. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms, etc. Audit observation on financial transaction with regard to compliance with the Law, Rules & Regulations (Propriety and Regularity), and efficiency-cum-performance aspects etc., if any, are reported through Inspection Reports/CAG's Audit Reports separately.

3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidences and supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

4. Based on our audit, we report that:

- i) We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit.
- ii) The Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the format approved by the Ministry of Finance.
- iii) In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by CARA in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.
- iv) We further report that:

A. General

A.1 As per investment pattern prescribed by the Ministry of Finance in 2015 for investment of non-government provident funds, superannuation funds and gratuity funds, up to 45 *per cent* amount could be invested in Term Deposit Receipts of Banks. CARA invested the entire accumulated funds amounting to Rs. 254.15 lakh of Gratuity and Leave Salary in fixed deposits of Syndicate Bank and Union Bank of India, which was inconsistent with the pattern prescribed by the Ministry of Finance. CARA has assured (October 2022) that remedial action is underway and is expected to be completed during 2022-23.

A.2. Advances amounting to Rs. 11.13 crore were lying outstanding as on 31.03.2022 (Schedule - 11), out of which an amount of Rs. 10.96 crore was lying outstanding from 2008-09 to 2021-22. This issue was also raised in previous year Separate Audit Report. Urgent action may be taken to settle the outstanding advances.

B. Grants-in-Aid

CARA received a grant of Rs. 658.00 lakh during 2021-22 from Ministry of Women and Child Development. Out of this, Rs. 84.00 lakh was received in the month of March 2022. It had an unspent balance of Grant-in-aid of previous year of Rs. 44.34 lakh (returned to MWCD & CFI). It had an internal receipt of Rs. 10.55 lakh. Out of the total of Rs. 668.55 lakh, CARA had utilized an amount of Rs 642.71 lakh leaving an unspent grant of Rs. 25.84 lakh.

C. Management letter



- (a) In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet of the state of affairs of the Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA), New Delhi, as at 31 March, 2022 and
- (b) In so far as, it relates to Income and Expenditure Account of the **surplus** for the year ended on that date.

3. System of physical verification of fixed assets


The physical verification of fixed assets was conducted up to 31.03.2022.

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


