PYRAMID CHART ON FUNCTIONING OF CHILD PROTECTION SYSTEM FOR OAS CHILDREN

Local SAA/CCI /Police

- SAA/CCI- Identification, admission and registration of children in need of care and protection; Preparation of ICP, CSR& MER of child and HSR of PAPs; Assisting CWC for LFA; Providing counselling to children and PAPs; Assisting for adoption order and birth Certificate; Maintaining records
- **Police-** Police to produce child before CWC, provide clearance for child's LFA

District Level DCPU/CWC/ DM

- DCPU- Ensureeffective implementation of child protection programs and policies related to children in the district and local level, work under the supervision of DM, head the Adoption committee meeting, inspect institutions, recommend for recognition of SAA to the State Govt. and link SAA-CCI on CARINGS
- CWC- Authorized to dispose cases for care, protection, treatment, development and rehabilitation of CNCP, declare children for LFA
- **DM-** Responsible for effective implementation of the JJ Act including issue of adoption order.

State SARA

• SARA- To coordinate, support and monitor all the work related to adoption and non-institutional care in the state; To conduct awareness and training for capacity building of stakeholders in the process of adoption; To function as a State Nodal Body in adoption related matters.

• **CARA-** Nodal body for promoting In-country Adoptions and regulating Inter-country Adoptions
